

Website Cookie Policy

We use cookies on this website to improve performance and enhance the user experience. This policy explains how we do that.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you first visit a site or page. The cookie will help the website to recognise your device the next time you visit. We use the term "cookies" in this policy to refer to all files that collect information in this way.

There are many functions cookies serve. For example, they can help us to analyse how well our website is performing, or remember choices you have made, for example clicking to remove the cookie notification so it is not displayed the next time you visit this site on the same device.

What sort of cookies does this website use?

Our cookies are used for the following functions:

- **Essential cookies**

Some cookies are essential for the operation of this website. For example, the order form contents are stored in a cookie while you browse the site.

- **Performance Cookies**

We utilise cookies to analyse how our visitors use our website and to monitor website performance. This allows us to provide a high-quality experience by customising our offering and quickly identifying and fixing any issues that arise. For example, we might use performance cookies to keep track of which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, and to determine why some pages are receiving error messages.

- **Functionality Cookies**

We use functionality cookies to allow us to remember your preferences. For example, cookies save you the trouble of typing in your username every time you access your account area (if enabled) and recall your customisation preferences from the database such as address details at the checkout. No personal details are stored in the cookie itself.
